In rural Tajikistan, many communities struggle with poverty, food insecurity, and limited opportunities – only 7% of the land is arable, and nearly a quarter of the population lives below the national poverty line. But there is hope. Sustainable aquaculture has the power to improve food security, create jobs, and strengthen local economies, if communities have access to the right training and support.

HOW FUNDS WILL HELP

This is where Ava's **Run for Resilience** comes in. In May 2026, PhD student Ava Drake (University of Stirling, Scotland) will run 200 miles across Tajikistan, turning every mile into action. Partnering with **Aquaculture without Frontiers (AwF)**, Ava is raising funds and awareness to empower communities to build sustainable aquaculture – helping transform lives, one step at a time.
